Albany, NY: Colin Patrick Barr, 50, died suddenly and peacefully at his home on July 7, 2016. He was born October 5, 1965, the youngest son of the late John Sullivan Barr and Patricia Fitzgerald Barr. He attended Albany High School and the Junior College of Albany. Charismatic and charming, Colin was a man of many talents. He was successful in several professional endeavors, including a ten-year career as a sales rep for Depuy Orthopedics in Florida, a prop maker and glazer on movies such as *The Majestic* and *Iron Man* in Los Angeles, and a proud member of Local 209 Painters and Allied Trade Union.

Colin's fierce pride of his Irish heritage, and his loyalty to the New York Yankees was exceeded only by his love for his family and friends.

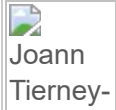
