Effie E. Musella 81, of Alcove passed away peacefully after a long illness on November 20, 2021 at St. Peter's Hospital.

Born in Albany, NY on September 30, 1940, she was the daughter of Marjorie Avery and Peter Erwin. Effie grew up in Albany and graduated from Albany high school in 1958. Upon graduation she worked for the NY State Law department and then as chief executive assistant to Dr. James Hepinstall, superintendent of Albany public schools. She also served as clerk to the Board of Education. After working for 11 years she enrolled in college and earned a bachelor's degree in accounting and economics from Russell Sage. In 1975 Effie went to work for NYSUT until her retirement in 2000. During that time she earned her master's degree in business administration from Russell Sage. After retirement Effie helped form the organization of NYSUT Staff Retirees (ONSR) and the development of the newsletter. Effie was a dancer in her younger years and taught ballroom dancing for four years. She loved to travel, cook, read and host holidays dinners at her home in Alcove. She always decorated every room for Christmas.

In addition to her parents, Effie was predeceased by her husband Benjamin Musella who died in 2007 and her dear friend Donald Godsnell. She is survived by her step children Laura Gee, Brian Musella and their families as well as cousins, nieces and nephews. She had many dear friends that were
