Ellen Louise Paigo, 72, of Fort Ann died Tuesday October 31st, 2017 at Glens Falls Hospital. Born in Albany, she was a resident of Colonie for many years and most recently resided in Fort Ann. Ellen was a graduate of the Vincentian Institute in Albany and was originally employed by NYNEX / Verizon and later the NYS Department of Corrections.
