Our Warrior battled with courage, patience, bravery, and determination. He was an inspiration to everyone, inspiring them to live their own lives to the fullest.

Gabriel was a Cub Scout, a Boy Scout, a member of Vocal Thunder, and an enthusiastic member of the Guilderland High School Robotics team where his role was programmer and driver. He loved to sing and participated in choir every year he was in school, culminating in First Place at the Music in the Park competition in Holyoke, MA.

Gabriel had a strong faith which took him from altar boy to reader at the children's mass to Adult Acolyte at St. Vincent's de Paul church.
