He was the owner and proprietor of Casey Finn's Pub & Grill on Yates Street in Albany for many years. Gary is survived by his wife of 22 years (together for 32 years) Sarah Martin Finning, daughter Gabrielle Finning, and his brothers Casey Trejo (Lindsey) and Johnson Casey (Wendy).
