Joseph P. Rosch, 68, passed away peacefully with his son and daughter by his side, at Halifax Hospice (Port Orange, FL.) Sunday, July 25, 2021.

Born on March 16, 1953 and raised in Albany by the late Ann and Frank J. 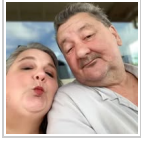
