Sister Mary Frederick Coyne (Mary Elizabeth Coyne) died Friday, November 21, 2025, at Teresian House in Albany, NY, after more than seven decades of selfless service as a Sister of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary.

Sister was born in Albany, NY, the daughter of Charles J. and Anna May Hickey Coyne. She was predeceased by her parents and three brothers: Charles V., Robert J., and Richard F. Coyne. She is survived by her loving extended family.

During her religious life, Sister taught in schools in Maryland and Florida, and at Mater Christi, Albany, and St. Thomas the Apostle, Delmar. After leaving the educational field, Sister served in Pastoral Care at St. Thomas and then volunteered at Hospice and St. Peter's Health Care Partners.
