Richard J. Stevens Obituary

It is with great sadness we announce the passing of Richard J. (Dickie) Stevens, 74, on March 9, 2025 at Albany Medical Center, surrounded by family and friends. Born in Albany, NY, on May 27, 1950, he was the son of the late Edward and Grace (McCarg) Stevens. Growing up in the Pine Hills, Dickie lived his entire life in Albany. He graduated from Albany High and later earned certificates from the Cornell University School of Industrial and Labor Relations.

Working for the State of New York for various agencies, he eventually found his calling as a passionate advocate for his fellow union members. Dickie served for many years as the Staff Director for the New York State Law Enforcement Officers Union, Council 82, dedicated to improving the overall quality of life for the men and women who diligently, professionally and self-sacrificingly served their communities.

Beyond his professional life, Dickie was known for his love of life. He was a gifted story teller who entertained family and friends at every opportunity. He was a die-hard NY Yankees and NY Football Giants fan, who enjoyed visiting Yankee Stadium and MetLife (Giants) Stadium every year. Of course, you could find him every August, under a shady tree at the Saratoga Race Course.

Above all, Dickie was deeply devoted to his family, most especially his best friend and the love of his life, Karen (Pfeiffer) Stevens. High school

sweethearts, Dickie and Karen were married for 51 years. He cherished their two children, Richard (Ricky) W. E. Stevens and Meghan K. Stevens (Michio Cohen). He reveled in taking them to their first ball games, Beach Boy concerts and spending time with them at their favorite vacation spots, Marco Island, Las Vegas and Atlantic City . He instilled in them a love of the Beatles and at an early age taught them the words to “American Pie.”

Dickie is also survived by his sister Nancy Elia (Nick), brother James Stevens (Nora), his sisters-in law Dixie Stevens, Janis Pfeiffer, Eileen Pfeiffer, Lisa Przekurat (late Jim), Patricia Rigosu (Vinny), brother-in-law Michael Pfeiffer, a host of nieces, nephews and countless friends.

In addition to his parents, Dickie was predeceased by his brothers Edward (Rose Marie), William, sister Sharyn Pallozzi (Tom) and nephew Brian Pallozzi.
