Family was everything to her, and if you know her, you already know that. She had endless love for her son, Edward, his wife Laura, and her two grandsons, Sean and Matthew. 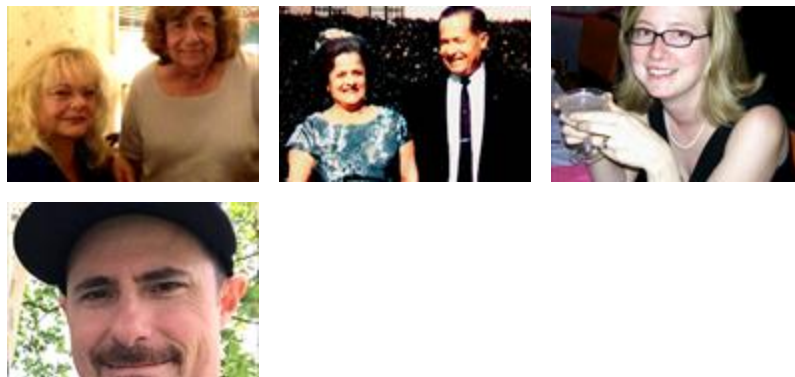
